## UA Local 400, Boldt and Union Construction Trades Donate Labor and Materials to Keep Kitchen Open at Appleton's American Legion Post 38...Saving Its Legendary Friday Fish Fry

Kaukauna Wis. (June 1, 2022) – More than 12,000 American Legion posts closed for at least part of the pandemic. Those closures left some posts in financial trouble. Besides the pandemic, American Legion Post 38 in Appleton, Wisconsin was in dire need of upgrading the plumbing and electrical for the group's outdated kitchen, which was recently deemed not up to code. <u>UA 400 Pipe Trades</u> is proud to support all our veterans. UA Local 400 and Boldt along with these local contractors and union trades including <u>Laborers Local 330</u>, <u>Sargent Electric, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 577</u>, <u>Bassett Mechanical</u>, <u>Coenen Mechanical</u> and Viking Electric donated a total of \$70,000 in labor and materials for the entire kitchen remodel. Upon learning of the local legion's dilemma, UA 400 contacted <u>Boldt</u> and both organizations jumped in to help the veteran's group. Demo day kicked off Monday, May 16, 2022, with Boldt removing a 20' x 20' x 6' slab in the kitchen followed by UA 400 removing old piping piping, and Sargent Electric updating the electrical system. Once all the plumbing rework was completed to make the Legion kitchen code compliant, Boldt repoured the new concrete floor. After being closed for two weeks due to construction, the Legion's kitchen reopens on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> for its legendary Friday Fish Fry.
